An inter-ministerial coordination group in Luxembourg is continuously planning and preparing measures to be taken in the event of a COVID-19 infection¹. Though this is subject to change, the ATTF therefore continues to carry out its activities, in line with the Luxembourg government's instructions and recommendations.

We will be able to host **20** executives selected by the House of Training-ATTF. The selection will be based on objective criteria such as the applicants' present function as well as their professional exposure. Please note that a sound command of English is required.

Who should attend and how to apply? Deadline to apply: April 9, 2020.

If you are a **C-level executive (CEO, CFO, COO, CRO, etc.), direct report or a board member**, you are in the scope of this Executive Programme, built just for you. Not only will the content be highly relevant for you, but it will also be a unique platform to network with peers from around the world.
